

Ordinance No. 792-2020

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

Authorizing the Director of Public Utilities to enter into one or more contracts with Motorola Solutions, Inc. for professional services necessary to provide the update to the microwave system proprietary equipment and for maintenance and service of hardware and software, for the Office of Radio Communications, Department of Public Utilities, for a period of four years.

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That the Director of Public Utilities is authorized to enter into one or more contracts with Motorola Solutions, Inc. for professional services necessary to provide the update to the microwave system proprietary equipment, including ancillary equipment and services needed to implement the update, and for the maintenance and service of hardware and software, on the basis of its proposal dated June 19, 2020, for the Office of Radio Communications, Department of Public Utilities. The contract or contracts shall be paid from Fund No. 50 SF 002, 52 SF 001, and from the fund or funds to which are credited future bonds, if issued for this purpose, RQS 2002, RL 2020-82.

Section 2. That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
