

Ordinance No. 1221-2025

**By Council Members Bishop and Griffin
(by departmental request)**

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

Authorizing the Director of Parks and Recreation and/or Director of Public Works and/or the Director of Finance to contract with one or more temporary employment agencies to provide professional services to supply temporary and seasonal personnel for the Department of Parks and Recreation and/or Department of Public Works and the Project Clean program, and for various other departments of the City, for a period up to one year.

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That the Director of Parks and Recreation and/or the Director of Public Works and/or the Director of Finance is authorized to enter one or more contracts, for a period up to one year each, with one or more temporary employment agency or agencies for the purpose of supplementing the regularly employed staff of the several departments of the City of Cleveland to provide the professional services necessary to supply temporary and/or seasonal personnel for the Department of Parks and Recreation and/or the Department of Public Works and the Project Clean program.

The selection of the agency or agencies shall be made by the Board of Control on the nomination of the Director of Parks and Recreation and/or the Director of Public Works and/or the Director of Finance from a list of qualified agencies available for employment as may be determined after a full and complete canvass by the Director of Parks and Recreation and/or the Director of Public Works and/or the Director of Finance for the purpose of compiling a list. The compensation to be paid for the services shall be fixed by the Board of Control. The contract or contracts authorized shall be prepared by the Director of Law, approved by the Director of Parks and Recreation and/or Director of Public Works and/or the Director of Finance, as appropriate, and funds certified by the Director of Finance.

Section 2. That the cost of the contract or contracts authorized shall be paid from Fund No. 01-7001-6380 and other funds approved by the Director of Finance.

Section 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by

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the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
