

## Department of Port Control

Ordinance No.: 951-2025

### Council Summary

The Department of Port Control is requesting authority to enter into a direct award requirement contract with Cummins Inc. for labor and materials, equipment, supplies, training, and parts to repair, replace, refurbish, maintain, upfit, and enhance heavy duty machinery and equipment, for a period of one-year, with three (3) one-year options to renew, exercisable by the Director of Port Control.

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#### Background/Purpose:

This legislation will ensure that the required machines, equipment, supplies, parts, materials, labor, and services are available to make repairs, maintain, upfit, replace, and enhance equipment for the Department of Port Control (DPC). Ensuring these machines and equipment are kept in good working condition will aid the workforce at DPC in completing jobs more efficiently, which enables DPC to meet operational needs.

#### Anticipated Cost:

Approximately \$60,000.00 annually

#### Schedule or Term of Contract:

One-year, with three (3) one-year options to renew, exercisable by the Director of Port Control.
