AN EMERGENCY RESOLUTION

Supporting the West Creek Conservancy’s Clean Ohio Green Space FY27 Grant application to the Ohio Public Works Commission for the Irishtown Bend Restoration Phase II Project.

WHEREAS, West Creek Conservancy is applying for a Clean Ohio Green Space FY27 Grant to obtain funding for park improvements, including construction of a trail connecting the Towpath Trail to the lakefront and construction of a 25-acre riverfront park; and

WHEREAS, the City of Cleveland supports West Creek Conservancy’s grant application and respectfully requests that the Ohio Public Works Commission favorably consider West Creek Conservancy’s grant application for funding; and

WHEREAS, this resolution constitutes an emergency measure for the immediate preservation of public peace, property, health or safety, now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That the City of Cleveland supports West Creek Conservancy’s Clean Ohio Green Space FY27 Grant application to the Ohio Public Works Commission for the Irishtown Bend Restoration Phase II Project.

Section 2. That the Clerk of Council is directed to transmit a certified copy of this resolution to West Creek Conservancy, Attention: Derek Schafer, PO BOX 347113, Parma, OH 44134.

Section 3. That this resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
