AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

Authorizing the Director of Public Works to enter into a license agreement with Midtown Cleveland, Inc., or its designee, to install and maintain a gateway monument sign at Colonel Charles Young Park, located at the intersection of Prospect Street and East 46th Street.

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That, notwithstanding Section 183.16 of the Codified Ordinances of Cleveland, Ohio, the Director of Public Works is authorized to enter into a license agreement with Midtown Cleveland, Inc., or its designee (“Midtown”), whereby the City is granting Midtown the right to install and maintain a gateway monument sign at Colonel Charles Young Park, located at the intersection of Prospect Street and East 46th Street, also known as Permanent Parcel No. 103-17-015 and more fully described as:

Situated in the City of Cleveland County of Cuyahoga and State of Ohio, and known as being part of Sublot No. 9 in Henry F. Clark’s Subdivision of part of Original Ten Acre Lot No. 71 as shown in Volume 3, Page 37 of Cuyahoga County Map Records further described as follows:

(To the center of planter)

Located in Colonel Chas. Young Square within the existing circular brick planter approximately 79 feet south of the south right of way of Prospect Avenue (82.50 feet wide) and 16’ feet west of the west right of way of the East 46th Street (60.00 feet wide).

Section 2. That the term of the license agreement shall be for three years and will automatically renew from year to year unless terminated by either party.

Section 3. That the license agreement shall be prepared by the Director of Law which shall include the requirement that Midtown maintain and repair sign as necessary at no cost to the City during the term of the agreement and remove the sign at no cost to the City when the agreement is terminated.

Section 4. That the Director of Public Works and the Director of Law, and other appropriate City officials, are authorized to execute such other documents and certificates, and take such other action as may be necessary or appropriate to effect the license agreement authorized by this ordinance.

Section 5. That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
