EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The Department of Port Control is requesting authority to exercise the first option to renew Contract No. PI 2016-38 with The Shelly Company to provide for the public improvement of repairing and maintaining runways, taxiways, ramps, roads, and other asphalt surfaces, for the various divisions of the Department of Port Control.

Background/Purpose:

The Department of Port Control is required to maintain all runways, taxiways, ramps, and roadways in good condition, free and clear of potholes, cracks, etc. to ensure the safe operation of aircraft and motor vehicles at Cleveland Hopkins International and Burke Lakefront airports.

Scope of Work:

To provide asphalt, labor and materials required to maintain and repair the runways, taxiways, ramps and roadways at Cleveland Hopkins International and Burke Lakefront airports, on an as needed basis or as required by the Department of Port Control.

Justification/Urgency:

These services are required to ensure compliance with FAA Part 139 requirements for the safe operation of aircraft and motor vehicles operating on the runways, taxiways, ramps and roadways at Cleveland Hopkins International and Burke Lakefront airports. These services are required to perform major repairs which are outside the scope of the Department's capability to perform. The current contract for these services will expire March 19th, 2019.

The Department of Port Control is requesting that this contract(s) have a term of two years with two one-year options for renewal, the first of which is exercisable by additional legislative authority.
