

Ordinance No. 395-2023

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

Authorizing the Director of Finance to enter into an amendment to Contract No. PS 2019-209 with OhioGuidestone to continue to provide evidence or research-based programs and activities in City Neighborhood Resource and Recreation Centers, for up to eighteen additional months.

WHEREAS, under Ordinance No. 387-2019, passed April 15, 2019, and Board of Control Resolution No. 164-2019, adopted May 1, 2019, the Director of Finance entered into Contract No. PS 2019-209 with OhioGuidestone to provide evidence or research-based programs and activities in City Neighborhood Resource and Recreation Centers for a period of one year; and

WHEREAS, under Ordinance No. 811-2020, passed November 18, 2020, this Council authorized amendments to agreements entered into under the authority of Ordinance No. 387-2019, to include additional contract provisions, a revision of the scope of services and fees, consultants, and an additional one-year period on the contracts due to the the inability of the consultants to provide some or all of the services due to the COVID-19 declared emergencies; and

WHEREAS, additional time is necessary for OhioGuidestone to provide its intended services; and

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That the Director of Finance is authorized to enter into an amendment to Contract No. PS 2019-209 with OhioGuidestone to extend the term of its existing contract up to additional eighteen months, in order to continue to provide evidence or research-based programs and activities in City Neighborhood and Recreation Centers.

Section 2. That the amendment shall be prepared by the Director of Law.

Section 3. That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
