AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

Amending Section 1 of Ordinance No. 826-2019, passed July 24, 2019 as it pertains to authorizing the Director of the Department of Community Development to enter into agreement with Burten, Bell, Carr Development Inc. for the Buckeye Summer Soul Series Project through the use of Ward 6 Casino Revenue Funds.

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That Section 1 of Ordinance No. 826-2019, passed July 24, 2019, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 1. That the Director of the Department of Community Development is hereby authorized to enter into agreement effective <u>July 1, 2018</u> with Burten, Bell, Carr Development Inc. for the Buckeye Summer Soul Series Project for the public purpose of providing health and wellness education to residents residing in the city of Cleveland through the use of Ward 6 Casino Revenue Funds.

Section 2. That Section 1 of Ordinance No. 826-2019, passed July 24, 2019, is hereby repealed.

Section 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
