WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That the Director of Human Resources is authorized to exercise the second option to renew Contract No. CT 0402, PS 2017-227 with The Fedeli Group to analyze health care providers, benefits, and claims, and to evaluate proposals received for benefit management services, among other things. This ordinance constitutes the additional legislative authority required by Ordinance No. 1031-16 to exercise this option.

<u>Section 2.</u> That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
