

Ordinance No.756-2026

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

Authorizing the Director of Public Safety to apply for and accept a grant from the Ohio Department of Public Safety for the FY 2027 Impaired Driving Enforcement Program and Selective Traffic Enforcement Program.

FOR PASSAGE
July 15, 2026

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That the Director of Public Safety is authorized to apply for and accept the FY 2027 Impaired Driving Enforcement Program and Selective Traffic Enforcement Program (“IDEP/STEP”) grant in the approximate amount of \$30,271.98, and any other funds that may become available during the grant term from the Ohio Department of Public Safety for funding speed-related and DUI-related traffic enforcement and reimbursement of officer overtime; that the Director is authorized to file all papers and execute all documents necessary to receive the funds under the grant; and that the funds are appropriated for the purposes described in the IDEP/STEP Proposal 2027 for the grant contained in the file described below.

Section 2. That IDEP/STEP Proposal 2027 for the grant, File No.**756-2026-A**, made a part of this ordinance as if fully rewritten, is approved in all respects and shall not be changed without additional legislative authority. (RQS 6002, RLA 2026-84)

Section 3. That the Director of Public Safety is authorized to extend the term of the grant.

Section 4. That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
