Ordinance No. 1335-2024

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

To make temporary appropriations for the current payrolls and other ordinary expenses of the City of Cleveland from the period from January 1, 2025 until the effective date of the annual appropriation ordinance for the fiscal year ending December 31, 2025.

WHEREAS, it is desired to postpone the passage of the annual appropriation ordinance until the amended certificate is received, based on the actual balances as the same may be determined by the Director of Finance and the County Budget Commission; and

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

<u>Section 1</u>. To provide for the current payrolls, sinking fund and other ordinary expenses of the City of Cleveland for the period from January 1, 2025 until the effective date of the Annual Appropriation Ordinance for the fiscal year ending December 31, 2025, there be and there is hereby appropriated for the period from January 1, 2025 until the effective date of the Annual Appropriation Seven Hundred Seventy Nine Million, Nine Hundred Nine Thousand, Six Hundred Ninety Six Dollars (\$779,909,696) out of taxes due the City of Cleveland and any other revenues accrued or occurring during said period of time and said funds are respectively appropriated as follows:

<u>Section 2</u>. That all expenditures and payments made under and pursuant to the ordinance appropriating such sum or sums of money shall be charged against the annual appropriation ordinance for the fiscal year ending December 31, 2025, when such appropriation ordinance shall become effective, and to the various departments and divisions and payment of whose officers and employees and operating expenses such sum or sums of money hereunder shall then have paid out or expended. Provided, however, that no payment shall be made under the authority of this ordinance after the effective date of said Annual Appropriation Ordinance for the fiscal year ending December 31, 2025.

<u>Section 3</u>. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
