Re: Ratification of OPBA PSU Collective Bargaining Agreement and Pay Band Legislation – July 9, 2025 Meeting

Dear President Griffin:

I am requesting legislation to be passed <u>under suspension</u> at the July 9, 2025 meeting:

- Ratification of the successor collective bargaining agreement for 04/01/22 03/31/25 reached between the City of Cleveland and the Ohio Patrolmen's Benevolent Association (Protective Services Unit); and
- Amend Pay Band Section 14 in Ordinance 194-2021. The maximum rates are increased by one-half (1/2) percent to account for any rounding issues at time of implementation.

I am requesting this legislation be addressed under suspension, as it became effective 04/01/22, for the implementation of terms and conditions of the collective bargaining, including compensation.
