## AN EMERGENCY RESOLUTION

Appointing one member to the Civilian  
Police Review Board.

### FOR ADOPTION

WHEREAS, Section 115-2 of the Charter of the City of Cleveland, effective November 8, 2016, requires that Council appoint four members to the nine-member Civilian Police Review Board; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Charter Section 115-2, Council requested and has reviewed applications to fill a recently vacated seat for a term ending August 8, 2024, and has selected from the applicants a member to the Board whose term begins immediately upon adoption of this Resolution; and

WHEREAS, this resolution constitutes an emergency measure for the immediate preservation of public peace, property, health or safety, in that Council must fill one recently vacated seat on the Civilian Police Review Board so that it complies with its obligations under the Charter, now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That this Council hereby appoints Glenn Parker III to the Civilian Police Review Board for a term beginning on July 10, 2024, and ending on August 8, 2024.

Section 2. That this resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
