

**Ordinance No. 343-2020****AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE**

To amend Sections 9, 10, 12, 18, 28, 55 and 56 of Ordinance No. 323-15, passed March 30, 2015, as amended, relating to compensation for various classifications.

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:
