

Ordinance No. 917-2021

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

Authorizing the Director of Public Utilities to employ one or more professional consultants necessary to design rehabilitation of automatic control systems at the Division of Water's treatment plants, secondary facilities, and in the distribution system, for the Division of Water, Department of Public Utilities.

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That the Director of Public Utilities is authorized to employ by contract or contracts one or more consultants or more firms of consultants for the purpose of supplementing the regularly employed staff of the several departments of the City of Cleveland necessary to design rehabilitation of automatic control systems at the Division of Water's treatment plants, secondary facilities, and in the distribution system.

Section 2. The selection of the consultants for the services described above shall be made by the Board of Control on the nomination of the Director of Public Utilities from a list of qualified consultants available for employment as may be determined after a full and complete canvass by the Director of Public Utilities for the purpose of compiling a list. The compensation to be paid for the services shall be fixed by the Board of Control. The contract or contracts authorized shall be prepared by the Director of Law, approved by the Director of Public Utilities, and certified by the Director of Finance.

Section 2. That the cost of the contract or contracts authorized shall be paid from Fund No. 52 SF 001 and fund the fund or funds to which are credited the proceeds from the sale of future bonds, if issued for this purpose. (RQS 2002, RL 2021-76)

Section 3. That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
