DIVISION: Recreation

ORDINANCE NO: 990-2025

DESCRIPTION: This project offers a wide range of baseball and softball activities for youth/teenagers residing in the City of Cleveland, free of charge. Participants remain engaged during the summer with fun, safe, and constructive team pursuits, while meeting new friends and learning about the sports of baseball and girls fast-pitch softball.

TERM: June 2, 2025 through August 8, 2025
