2022 Summer Food Service Program-Camp George Forbes

DIVISION: Recreation

ORDINANCE NO: 758-2021

LEGISLATIVE PURPOSE: Authorizing the Director of Public Works to accept a State of Ohio reimbursement grant from the Ohio Department of Education for the 2022 Summer Food Service Program at Camp George Forbes, for a period of one program year, with a one-year option to renew, exercisable by the Director of Public Works.

ESTIMATED EXTERNAL AMOUNT: \$100,000.00

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The Division of Recreation applies for this annual State of Ohio reimbursement grant to provide nutritious meals to children during the summer. The meals are free to Cleveland children 18 years old and younger and are distributed and consumed at Camp George Forbes.

PROGRAM PERIOD: The 2022 program year will begin in June 7<sup>th</sup> and end on August 6<sup>th</sup>. Meals will be served Monday through Friday.

PREVIOUS VENDOR: **Gordon Food Service, Inc.** Budget Year: 2021

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION: **Self-Prepared Program** – the State of Ohio reimbursement grant funds meals at Camp Forbes that are prepared on-site by cooks employed by the City of Cleveland. The cooks prepare breakfast, lunch, and dinner for the 100 youth that attend camp weekly during the 8-week summer program.

The menu is approved by the Ohio Department of Education for nutritional content. A typical lunch meal consists of:

- 2 oz. meat/poultry/fish/meat alternate
- ¾ cup vegetable and/or fruit (2 or more)
- 1 slice bread or bread alternate
- 1-cup milk

The City is reimbursed for all meals properly recorded and served within the guidelines of the program.
