

# Ordinance No. 72-2024

## AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

Authorizing the Director of Finance to enter into an agreement with The National Forum For Black Public Administrators, an AmeriCorps Vista, for the placement of an intern in the Department of Finance, Division of Information Technology Services, to provide support for the City's broadband initiative, for a period of one year.

WHEREAS, The National Forum For Black Public Administrators, through its AmeriCorps Vista program, wishes to place an intern, at no cost to the City, to assist the City in implementing the City's broadband initiative; and

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That the Director of Finance is authorized to enter into an agreement and execute any other necessary documents with The National Forum For Black Public Administrators, an AmeriCorps Vista, for the placement of an intern in the Department of Finance, Division of Information Technology Services, to provide support of the City's broadband initiative, for a period of one year.

Section 2. That the agreement and cost of the intern shall be at no cost to the City.

Section 3. That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
