### **AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE**

Authorizing the Director of Economic Development to enter into one or more grant agreements with Eagle Family Foods Group, LLC and/or its designee, to provide economic development assistance to partially finance Project Sticky located at 1975 East 61st Street.

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

### BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That the Director of Economic Development is authorized to enter into one or more grant agreements with Eagle Family Foods Group, LLC, and/or its designee, a recoverable grant in an amount not to exceed \$427,500 to assist with the construction of improvements, and a job-based incentive grant in an amount not to exceed \$228,185, to provide a total of \$655,685 in economic development assistance to partially finance Project Sticky located at 1975 East 61st Street.

Section 2. That the agreement or agreements and other appropriate documents needed to complete the transaction authorized by this legislation shall be prepared by the Director of Law.

Section 3. That the agreement or agreements authorized in this legislation will require the recipients of financial assistance to work with, and/or cause their tenants to work with, The Workforce Investment Board for Workforce Area No. 3 to identify and solicit qualified candidates for job opportunities related to the City's contracts, and place special emphasis on the hard to employ, including but not limited to the disabled and persons who have been convicted of or have pled guilty to a criminal offense, unless the criminal conviction or circumstances relate to the duties for the particular job sought.

Section 4. That the costs of the grants shall not exceed an aggregate amount of \$655,685.00 and shall be paid from Fund No. 10 SF 501, Request No. RQS 9501, RL 2019-110.

Section 5. That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
