February 5, 2024**

Dear Council President Griffin:

I am writing to ask your support for Passage under Suspension of the Rules on February 5, 2024, of an emergency ordinance authorizing payment to Stoneco Inc. dba Allied Corporation for the cost of providing asphalt materials to the Division of Streets from July 9, 2023 to August 30, 2023.

The reason we are asking for Passage under Suspension of the Rules is because Allied Corporation provided asphalt materials to the Division of Streets through contract RC2021*64; this contract expired on July 8, 2023. The Division did not have a contract in place for asphalt materials at the time of the contract's expiration. Consequently, the Division continued to accept asphalt materials from Allied until August 30, 2023. After August 30, 2023, the Division entered into a contract with a new vendor, Kokosing Materials, Inc.

The source of funding will be taken from program C22209 and any funds deemed appropriate by the Director of Finance.
