

Ordinance No. 1055-2021

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

Authorizing the Director of Finance, on behalf of the Cleveland Municipal Court, to apply for and accept a grant from the Alcohol, Drug Addiction and Mental Health Services Board of Cuyahoga County for the 2021-2022 Specialized Dockets Program; and authorizing the Director to enter into one or more contracts with various agencies, entities, or individuals to implement the grant.

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That the Director of Finance, on behalf of the Cleveland Municipal Court, is authorized to apply for and accept a grant in the amount of \$200,000, and any other funds that become available during the grant term, for the 2021-2022 Specialized Dockets Program from the Alcohol, Drug Addiction and Mental Health Services Board of Cuyahoga County (“ADAMHS Board”); that the Director is authorized to file all papers and execute all documents necessary to receive the funds under the grant; and that the funds are appropriated for the purposes described in the legislative summary for the grant contained in the file described below.

Section 2. That the legislative summary for the grant, **File No. 1055-2021-A**, made a part of this ordinance as if fully rewritten, is approved in all respects and shall not be changed without further legislative authority.

Section 3. That the Director of Finance, on behalf of the Cleveland Municipal Court, is authorized to enter into one or more contracts with or make payments to other agencies, entities, or individuals to implement the grant as described in the file.

Section 4. That the costs of the contract or contracts or any payments authorized by this ordinance shall be paid from the fund or funds to which are credited the grant funds accepted under this ordinance.

Section 5. That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
