SUBJECT: Ordinance No. 868-2022 Authorizing the Director of Public Safety to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding with the United States Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives relating to reimbursement of overtime salary costs and other costs incurred by the Cleveland Division of Police in providing resources to assist the ATF, terminating on September 30, 2027.

DATE: September 28, 2022

Ordinance No. 868-2022, if passed by Council, would authorize the Director of Public Safety to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding with the ATF for reimbursement of overtime salary costs and other costs incurred by the Cleveland Division of Police (CDP) in providing resources to assist the Task Force. This agreement will terminate on September 30, 2027.

The costs to be reimbursed include, but are not limited to, overtime salary costs, travel, fuel, and training and equipment costs incurred by the CDP in providing resources or assistance to the Task Force while assisting in joint law enforcement operations.
