

Ordinance No. 683-2026

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

Authorizing the Director of Public Safety to enter into one or more contracts with Flock Group, Inc. dba Flock Safety for the acquisition and or renewal of the annual license and the professional services of maintenance for the Flock Safety Automated License Plate Reader Solution for the Division of Police, Department of Public Safety, for a period of one year.

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That the Director of Public Safety is authorized to enter into one or more contracts with Flock Group, Inc. dba Flock Safety for acquisition and or renewal of the annual license and the professional services of maintenance for the Flock Safety Automated License Plate Reader Solution including software, and for the acquisition and/or renewal of licenses, for use by the Division of Police, Department of Public Safety, for a period of one year at a cost not to exceed \$250,000.

Section 2. That under Section 108(b) of the Charter, the services authorized by this ordinance may be made through cooperative arrangements with other governmental agencies. The Director of Public Safety may sign all documents that are necessary to obtain such services, and may enter into one or more contracts with the vendors or consultants selected through that cooperative process.

Section 3. That the cost of the contract or contracts shall be paid from Fund No. 01-6002-6612. (RQS 6002, RL 2026-43).

Section 4. That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
