Legislative Purpose:	Authorizing the Director of the Mayor's Office of Capital Projects and/or City Planning to enter into three contracts with artists pursuant to Chapter 186 of the Codified Ordinances of Cleveland, Ohio, 1976.
Project Summary:	Chapter 186 of the Codified Ordinances of Cleveland, Ohio, 1976 establishes a Public Art Program (PAP) to promote the welfare and prosperity of the community through the experience of art in public places. The PAP is administered by the City Planning Commission (CPC), with the assistance of its staff and advisory committee known as the Public Art Committee (PAC), and in conjunction with the Mayor's Office of Capital Projects (MOCAP).
	Pursuant to Chapter 186, the PAC solicited artists to design, produce, and install public art for three City projects: the renovation of the Clark Recreation Center, the renovation of the Sterling Recreation, and the new Fire Station #26. The PAC selected an artist for each City project based on the artist's qualifications and preliminary concepts, which will be refined through future community engagement.
