Project Description

PPNs: 026-04-001,-004,-007 & 026-34-001

Ward: Ward 17 (Councilperson Slife)

Site Area: 2.5808 acres

Zoning: Residential (Single Family)


Current Use: (2) vacant lots (Cleveland Clinic Foundation);

undeveloped wooded parcels (Cleveland Metroparks)

Project: The 1/3rd mile trail, 10-foot wide multi-purpose trail will traverse the area's steep topography near Fairview Hospital to create a new park connection for the 1,400 residents living within a half mile of Rocky River Reservation.

Request: To authorize acceptance of a 10-year easement from Cleveland Metroparks and contribute funds for the construction of the trail project.

- Easement needed to satisfy conditions for use of bond funds
- Has been reviewed and approved by bond counsel & Law Dept.
- City contributing \$750K match to Cuyahoga County + \$500K from Cleveland Clinic Foundation




