AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

Authorizing the Director of Port Control to exercise the first option to renew Contract No. CT 3001 LA 2017-025 with SWISSPORT USA, INC. to provide office and storage space to support aviation ground handling operations and maintenance services for various airlines at Cleveland Hopkins International Airport.

WHEREAS, under the authority of Ordinance No. 26-17, passed January 30, 2017, the Director of Port Control entered into Contract No. CT 3001 LA 2017-025 with SWISSPORT USA, INC. to provide office and storage space to support aviation ground handling operations and maintenance services for various airlines at Cleveland Hopkins International Airport; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 26-17 requires further legislation before exercising the first option to renew on this contract; and

WHEREAS, for the use of the Leased premises, SWISSPORT USA, INC. shall pay the City an annual fee as specified in the contract; and

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That the Director of Port Control is authorized to exercise the first option to renew Contract No. CT 3001 LA 2017-025 with SWISSPORT USA, INC. to provide office and storage space to support aviation ground handling operations and maintenance services for various airlines at Cleveland Hopkins International Airport. This ordinance constitutes the additional legislative authority required by Ordinance No. 26-17 to exercise this option.

Section 2. That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
