

Ordinance No. 127-2021

An emergency ordinance authorizing the Director of Port Control to exercise the second option to renew Contract No. PS 2019-273 with Glaus, Pyle, Schomer, Burns, and DeHaven, Inc. aka GPD Group to provide general engineering services on an as-needed basis for the Department of Port Control.

WHEREAS, under the authority of Ordinance No. 645-17, passed June 5, 2017, as amended by Ordinance No. 555-2019, passed May 20, 2019 (“Ordinance No. 645-17, as amended”), the Director of Port Control entered into Contract No. PS 2019-273 with Glaus, Pyle, Schomer, Burns, and DeHaven, Inc. aka GPD Group (“GPD Group”) to provide general engineering services on an as-needed basis for the Department of Port Control; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 645-17, as amended, requires further legislation before exercising the second option to renew on this contract; and

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That the Director of Port Control is authorized to exercise the second option to renew Contract No. PS 2019-273 with GPD Group to provide general engineering services on an as-needed basis for the Department of Port Control. This ordinance constitutes the additional legislative authority required by Ordinance No. 645-17, as amended, to exercise this option.

Section 2. That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
