

Ordinance No. 153-2021

An emergency ordinance amending the Title and Section 1 of Ordinance No. 201-2020, passed February 10, 2020, as amended by Ordinance No. 409-2020, passed May 27, 2020, as it pertains to authorizing the Director of the Department of Public Works to enter into an agreement with the Broadway School of Music and Arts for the Community Arts Instruction and Enrichment Program through the use of Wards 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16 and 17 Casino Revenue Funds.

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That the Title and Section 1 of Ordinance No. 201-2020, passed February 10, 2020, and amended by Ordinance No. 409-2020, passed May 27, 2020, is hereby amended to read as follows:

An emergency ordinance authorizing the Director of the Department of ~~Community Development~~ Public Works to enter into an agreement with the Broadway School of Music and Arts for the Community Arts Instruction and Enrichment Program through the use of Wards 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16 and 17 Casino Revenue Funds.

Section 1. That the Director of the Department of ~~Community Development~~ Public Works is authorized to enter into an agreement effective ~~January 1, 2019~~ February 1, 2018, with the Broadway School of Music and Arts for the Community Arts Instruction and Enrichment Program for the public purpose of providing music education to low and moderate income students residing in the city of Cleveland through the use of Wards 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16 and 17 Casino Revenue Funds.

Section 2. That the Title and Section 1 of Ordinance No. 201-2020, passed February 10, 2020, and amended by Ordinance No. 409-2020, passed May 27, 2020, is hereby repealed.

Section 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
