Executive Summary

The Department of Port Control is requesting authority to amend Section 139.17 of the Codified Ordinances of Cleveland, Ohio, 1976, relating to establishing a Customer Facility Charge (CFC) at Cleveland Hopkins International Airport, for on-Airport car rental customers.

Background/Purpose:

The Department of Port Control is requesting to amend Section 139.17:

Section 1, insert division (g) “The Director of Port Control is authorized to enter into agreements with the “RAC” necessary for any use authorized under division (e) of this section.”

Section 1 division (f), insert (3) “ To support payment of the cost of contract or contracts authorized under division (g) of this section, to be paid out of CFCs collected under section (c)”.

The Department of Port Control is requesting these changes to allow the “RAC” to conduct a traffic study, environmental site assessments, and preliminary designs necessary for the development of a new Consolidated Rent-A-Car (ConRAC) facility.
