## AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

To amend the title, Section 1 and Section 2 of Ordinance No. 978-2022, passed October 3, 2022, relating to a UDAG grant agreement contract with Team NEO, and/or its designee, to provide economic development assistance to induce Aer Lingus to start and maintain daily direct flight service from Cleveland to the Republic of Ireland.

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the

usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That the title, Section 1 and Section 2 of Ordinance No. 978-2022,

passed October 3, 2022, are amended to read as follows:

An Emergency Ordinance authorizing the Director of Economic Development to enter into a UDAG grant agreement contract with Team NEO, and/or its designee, to provide economic development assistance to induce Aer Lingus to start and maintain daily direct flight service from Cleveland to the Republic of Ireland for a period of three <u>four</u> years.

Section 1. That the Director of Economic Development is authorized to enter into a UDAG grant agreement contract with Team NEO, and/or its designee, to provide economic development assistance to induce Aer Lingus to start and maintain daily direct flight service from Cleveland to the Republic of Ireland for a period of three four years.

Section 2. That the terms of the grant shall be in accordance with the terms in the Summary contained in File No. <del>978-2022-A</del> <u>978-2022-A B</u>.

<u>Section 2.</u> That the existing title, Section 1 and Section 2 of Ordinance No.

978-2022, passed October 3, 2022, are repealed.

Section 3. That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
