AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE
Amending Section 4 of Ordinance No. 531-2023, passed May 31, 2023, authorizing the Director of Capital Projects and/or Port Control, as appropriate, to enter into one or more contracts with the Cleveland-Cuyahoga County Port Authority for the detailed design of the Early Implementation Phase of the Cleveland Harbor Eastern Embayment Resilience Strategy project; and authorizing the appropriate director to apply for and accept any gifts, grants or services from any public or private entity.

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That Section 4 of Ordinance No. 531-2023, passed May 31, 2023, is amended to read as follows:

Section 4. That the cost of this ordinance shall not exceed \$1,575,000, and shall be paid from Fund No. 10 SF 400, from the fund or funds to which are credited any gift or grant funds accepted under this ordinance, and from any other funds approved by the Director of Finance. (RQS 0103, RL 2023-48)

Section 2. That the existing Section 4 of Ordinance No. 531-2023, passed May 31, 2023, is repealed.

Section 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
