Executive Summary

The Department of Port Control is requesting authorization to enter into one or more requirement contracts of labor and materials necessary for painting and paint removal on roadways, runways and other paved surfaces, for the various divisions of the Department of Port Control, for a period of two years with two one-year options to renew, the first of which is exercisable through additional legislative authority.

Background/Purpose:

The Department is required by the Federal Aviation Administration to maintain required marking on all taxiways, runways and ramps in accordance with published Federal Aviation Standards.

Scope:

The scope of work will include painting and removal of existing markings on all taxiways, runways and ramps, in accordance with Federal Aviation Administration Advisory Circulars 150/5370-10A Change 14 and AC 150/5340-1J. Painting and paint removal may also be performed on the public side of Cleveland Hopkins International and Burke Lakefront airports.

Justification/Urgency:

Maintaining proper markings on the runways, taxiways and ramps is required by the Federal Aviation Administration. These markings must be periodically updated and/or refurbished to ensure that they are highly visible to pilots and ground service equipment operating on the Aircraft Operations Area as well as vehicular and pedestrian traffic operating on the public side of the airports.

The current contract for painting and paint removal will expire September 28, 2019.

Anticipated Cost:

The anticipated cost for these services is approximately \$1,500,000.00 for two years.

Schedule or Term of Contract:

The Department is requesting that this contract(s) have a term of two years with two one-year options to renew, the first of which would require additional legislative authority.
