Lorain Avenue Rehabilitation (West 65th Street to West 20th Street)
Amendment to Ordinance 1201-2022

Ordinance No. **351-2026**

Purpose: The Department is seeking legislative approval to amend Contract No. CT-0103-PS2023*0338 with Michael Baker International, Inc. to continue providing professional services for the Lorain Road (SR-10) improvement authorized under Ordinance No. 1201-2022, enacted January 26, 2023.

Description: Ordinance No. 1201-2023 accurately represents the project limits, scope, and funding, however Section 1 includes a reference to PID 89255 and the current project is programmed under PID 105932. To avoid potential unknown issues with removing the PID from Section 1, an amendment to the legislation to add the current PID will allow for the continuation of the contract with Michael Baker International, Inc. and also clarify that both PID numbers are recognized by ODOT for the funding programmed to complete the Lorain Avenue project.
