Authorizing the Director of City Planning to apply for and accept one or more grants from the Northeast Ohio Areawide Coordinating Agency (NOACA) and the Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT) for the 2021 Transportation for Livable Communities Initiative (TLCI); authorizing a tri-party agreement with NOACA and ODOT; authorizing agreements with various entities; accepting cash donations; and authorizing the Director to employ one or more professional consultants to implement the grant.

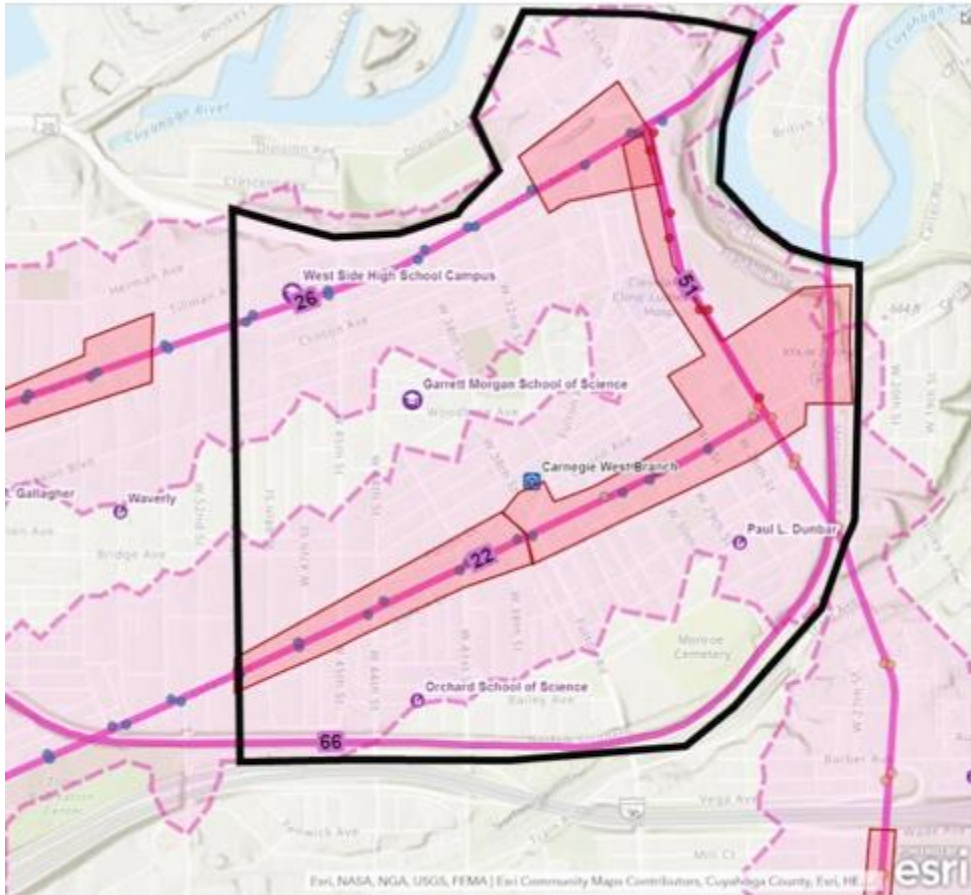

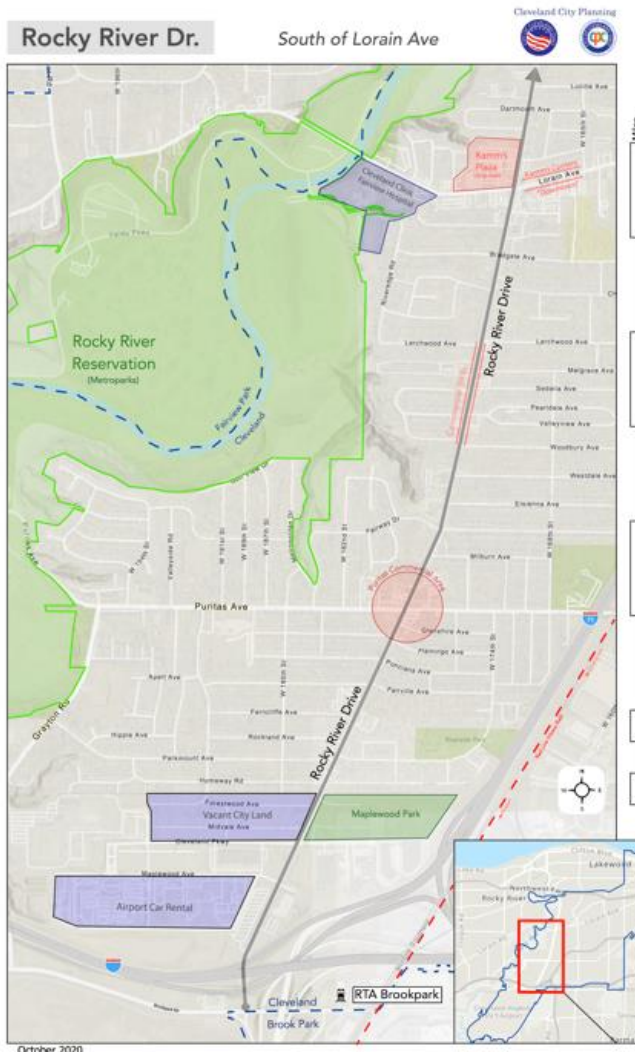
