AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

Authorizing the Director of Parks and Recreation to enter into one or more contracts with Ohio City Incorporated to provide a variety of family and youth programming activities.

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That the Director of Parks and Recreation is authorized to enter into one or more contracts with Ohio City Incorporated for the public purpose of providing Cleveland west side residents a variety of family and youth programming activities including but not limited to, sports clinics, arts programming, pickleball programs and a summer camp program such as described in the Ohio City Incorporated's Near West Recreation Program Scope of Work, placed in File No. 748-2026-A.

Section 2. That the cost of the contract or contracts shall not exceed \$100,000 and shall be paid from Fund No. 01-4503-6380. (RQS 4503, RL 2026-39)

Section 3. That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
