

Ordinance No. 252-2023

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

Authorizing the Director of Capital Projects to enter into one or more agreements with the Ohio Department of Transportation for the installation, maintenance, and ownership of signage within the State and United States Bike Route System within the City limits.

WHEREAS, the State and United States Bike Route System (the “Route”) is a network of bicycle routes that provide bicyclists with safe and convenient connections through and to population-centered destinations in Ohio; and

WHEREAS, the Cleveland portion of the Route is approximately 15 miles and follows a path along Lake Erie between West 117th Street and Neff Road/Lakeshore Boulevard; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Capital Projects desires to enter into an agreement with ODOT regarding the installation, maintenance, and ownership of the signage within the Route; and

WHEREAS, through the agreement, ODOT will supply and install the signage and the City will own and maintain the signage after installation; and

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That the Director of Capital Projects is authorized to enter into an agreement with ODOT for the installation, maintenance, and ownership of signage within the Route. A list of the proposed locations of the signage and a summary of the State and US Bike Route System are placed in **File No. 252-2023-A**.

Section 2. That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
