AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE
To amend Section 2 of Ordinance 1092-2025, passed September 15, 2025 relating to the agreement with Famicos Foundation for the Ward 10 Beautification and Litter Program as the ward existed December 10, 2025.

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That Section 2 of Ordinance No. 1092-2025, passed September 15, 2025, is amended to read as follows:

Section 2. That the cost of said contract shall be in an amount not to exceed \$27,340.00 and shall be paid from Fund No. 10 SF 188 using the fund and project number from the following Ward as it existed December 10, 2025:

Ward 10	\$27,340.00	G25348 G25766

Section 2. That the existing Section 2 of Ordinance 1092-2025, passed September 15, 2025 is hereby repealed.

Section 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
