Irishtown Bend and Franklin Reconstruction

Ordinance No. **592-2020**

Purpose: This Department requests legislation to authorize the Director of the Mayor's Office of Capital Projects or Director of Public Works; to enter into one or more agreements for the purpose of this public improvement; to grant consent and cause payment to Cleveland-Cuyahoga County Port Authority and to authorize the Division of Purchasing and Supplies to acquire, accept, and record all land necessary in making of the public improvement, including but not limited to gift, fee simple acquisitions, temporary easements, permanent easements, and work agreements; from any and all funds as authorized by Director of Finance.

Description: Irishtown Bend work includes stabilizing the hillside to prevent future landslides; replacing 2,600 feet of the deteriorated and dilapidated bulkhead/retaining wall; repairing damaged NEORS westerly interceptor sewer line; regrading of the hillside and reconstructing Franklin Avenue from West 25th Street to Columbus Road. The future of Irishtown Bend includes proposed plans for a 17-acre park. Cleveland-Cuyahoga County Port Authority is administering design and construction of these improvements.
