

Ordinance No. 248-2021

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

Approving the collective bargaining agreement with the International Longshoremen Association, Local 1317; and to amend Section 19 of Ordinance No. 194-2021, passed March 29, 2021, relating to compensation for various classifications.

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That under division (B) of Section 4117.10 of the Revised Code, this Council approves the collective bargaining agreement with International Longshoremen Association, Local 1317, under the terms contained in **File No. 248-2021-A**, for the period from April 1, 2019 through March 31, 2022, and which provides, among other things, for an increase in the salaries and wages for members of the bargaining unit under the following schedule:

| <u>Increase</u> | <u>Approximate Date of Increase</u> |
|-----------------|-------------------------------------|
| 2% | April 1, 2019 |
| 2% | April 1, 2020 |
| 2% | April 1, 2021 |

Section 2. That Section 19 of Ordinance No. 194-2021, passed March 29, 2021, is amended to read as follows:

Section 19. International Longshoreman Association, Local 1317. That salaries and compensation in the following classifications shall be fixed by the appointing authority in accordance with the schedule appearing after each classification:

| | <u>Minimum</u> | <u>Maximum</u> |
|-----------------------------------|----------------------------------|----------------------------------|
| 1 Bridge Attendant | 17.01 <u>18.41</u> | 17.70 <u>18.78</u> |
| 2 Electric Bridge Operator | 18.80 <u>20.35</u> | 19.56 <u>20.76</u> |
| 3 Electric Bridge Operator Leader | 20.13 <u>21.79</u> | 20.94 <u>22.23</u> |

Section 3. That existing Section 19 of Ordinance No. 194-2021, passed March 29, 2021 is repealed.

Section 4. That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
