

Ordinance No. 81-2026**By Council Member:** Starr**An emergency ordinance consenting and approving the issuance of a permit for the Inside the Park Homerun, June 21, 2026, managed by Hermes Sports & Events.**

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That pursuant to Section 411.06 of the Codified Ordinances of Cleveland, Ohio 1976, this Council consents to and approves the holding of the Inside the Park Homerun, June 21, 2026, managed by Hermes Sports & Events; **START** on Larry Doby Way (near East 9th Street and Eagle Avenue); left on East 9th Street; right on Bolivar Road; right on Prospect Avenue; right on East 36th Street; left on Carnegie Avenue; right through the parking lot at Minutemen (3740 Carnegie Avenue); left on Carnegie Avenue; right on East 36th Street; left on Prospect Avenue; left on Bolivar Road; left on East 9th Street; right on Larry Doby Way; **FINISH** inside Progressive Field, enter at the Right Field Gate (located on East 9th Street near Eagle Avenue/Larry Doby Way); provided that the applicant sponsor shall meet all the requirements of Section 411.05 of the Codified Ordinances of Cleveland, Ohio, 1976. Streets may be closed as determined by the Chief of Police and safety forces as may be necessary in order to protect the participants in the event. Said permit shall further provide that the City of Cleveland shall be fully indemnified from any and all liability resulting from the issuance of the same, to the extent and in form satisfactory to the Director of Law.

Section 2. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
