AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

**Council Members K. Johnson and Kelley
(by departmental request)**

Authorizing the Director of Public Works to exercise the second option to renew Contract No. CT 7005 PS 2016-140 with Tenable Protective Services, Inc. to provide for security services at the West Side Market Parking Lot and surrounding areas.

WHEREAS, under the authority of Ordinance No. 990-15, passed October 12, 2015, the Director of Public Works entered into Contract No. CT 7005 PS 2016-140 with Tenable Protective Services, Inc. to provide for security services at the West Side Market Parking Lot and surrounding areas; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 990-15 requires further legislation before exercising the second option to renew on this contract; and

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That the Director of Public Works is authorized to exercise the second option to renew Contract No. CT 7005 PS 2016-140 for an additional year with Tenable Protective Services, Inc. to provide for security services at the West Side Market Parking Lot and surrounding areas.

Section 2. That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
