AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

Authorizing the Director of Finance, on behalf of the Cleveland Municipal Court, Housing Division, to enter into an agreement with the Alcohol, Drug Addiction and Mental Health Services Board of Cuyahoga County to accept funding for the purpose of improving housing retention for tenants in eviction court.

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That the Director of Finance, on behalf of the Cleveland Municipal Court, Housing Division is authorized to enter into an Agreement with the Alcohol, Drug Addiction and Mental Health Services Board of Cuyahoga County to accept funding in the approximate amount of \$15,000 for the purpose of improving housing retention for tenants in eviction court. That the Director is authorized to file all papers and execute all documents necessary to receive the funds; and that the funds are appropriated for this purpose.

<u>Section 2.</u> That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
