**1<sup>st</sup> un-named alley West of Bellaire Road and North of Guardian  
Boulevard Intent to Vacate**

Resolution Number: 862-2019

Description: Declaring the intent to vacate a portion of the 1<sup>st</sup> un-named alley (10.00 feet wide) West of Bellaire Road and North of Guardian Boulevard.

Purpose: The purpose of this vacation request of the alley east of parcel 019-17-078 is for the purpose of establishing an urban garden and the installation of a high tunnel (hoop house).

The Cuyahoga Natural Resource Conservation Service (NRCS), a department of the United States Department of Agriculture, program mission is, "Helping People Help the Land". NRCS provides many products and services, both technical and financial, to help landowners be good stewards of the nation's soil, water and related natural resources.

The concept of high tunnels or hoop houses enables farmers to grow crops in regions with short growing seasons practically all year round with a highly efficient farming practice utilizing a hoop house.

The goal, once the hoop house is erected, is to grow organic fruits and vegetables not only for themselves but also for other health conscious individuals in our community and city.
