

Executive Summary
Age Friendly Home Investment Program

Background/Purpose:

This legislation amends Section 3 of Ordinance No. 675-18, passed by City Council on June 4, 2018 to add the Fund Numbers 01/001, 9997/00 and 6985.

This amendment will allow the Department of Aging to utilize funds from year 2 funding during the first year of the contract for the Age Friendly Home Investment Program (AFHIP). The additional funds are needed to provide assistance for roof and gutter repair and replacement, exterior painting, porch repairs or replacements, installation of ramps or lifts, major electrical work, detached garage structural repair, major plumbing repair including water tank replacement, broken window repair, concrete repair, floor repair, furnace repair or replacement and driveway patching and repair.

Goals:

- To provide an additional 120 or more older adult or disabled homeowners with a home repair to allow them to age in place.

Accomplishments:

- 95 AFHIP jobs are complete from Year 1 funding
- 30 AFHIP jobs are in process from Year 1 funding

Estimated Budget: \$75,000 per ward
