

THERE IS NO LEGAL OBJECTION TO THIS LEGISLATION IF AMENDED AS FOLLOWS:

1. In the title, line 7, after "Zone" insert "and to execute all necessary documents related thereto; authorizing the Commissioner of Purchases and Supplies to convey the real property under the first amendment;".

2. Insert a new Section 3 to read as follows:

"Section 3. That, notwithstanding any other ordinance or Codified Ordinance to the contrary and by and at the direction of the Board of Control, the Commissioner of Purchases and Supplies is authorized to convey by official deed(s) executed by the Mayor the real property described in the First Amendment which is no longer needed for the City's public use; and that the Mayor, Directors of Port Control and Law, and other appropriate City officials, as appropriate, are authorized to execute any other documents and certificates, and take any other actions which may be necessary or appropriate to effectuate the First Amendment."

3. Renumber existing Sections 3 and 4 to new "Section 4" and "Section 5".
