### Ord. No. 243-2025

By Council Members Bishop and Griffin (by departmental request)

An emergency ordinance to amend Section 133.31 of the Codified Ordinances of Cleveland, Ohio, 1976, as enacted by Ordinance No. 521-2024, passed July 10, 2024, relating to the Highland Park Golf Course and Banquet Room rates.

An emergency ordinance authorizing the Director of Capital Projects to enter into a Project Development Agreement with the Board of Park Commissioners of the Cleveland Metropolitan Park District regarding the design, construction, and use of four trail projects located within the City of Cleveland; to grant consent to Metroparks to construct the improvements; to apply for and accept any gifts or grants from any public or private entity; authorizing any relative agreements; authorize the Commissioner of Purchasing and Supplies to acquire and accept real property and easements; and causing payment of the City's share to Metroparks.
