AN EMERGENCY RESOLUTION

Supporting the Ohio Commission for the United States Semiquincentennial, AMERICA250-OH, and endorsing their mission to educate, preserve, innovate, and celebrate every Ohioan in every county.

WHEREAS, the Ohio legislature and the Governor created AMERICA250-OH in 2021 to plan, encourage, develop and coordinate the commemoration of the 250th anniversary of the United States and Ohio's integral role in that event and the role of its people on the nation's past, present and future; and

WHEREAS, AMERICA250-OH hopes to engage all Ohioans and all 88 counties through their many signatures and officially recognized programs, projects and events over the next several years by inspiring future leaders and celebrating all Ohioans' contributions to the nation over the last 250 years; and

WHEREAS, by adoption of AMERICA250-OH Resolution this Council hopes to educate, preserve, innovate, and celebrate; and

WHEREAS, this resolution constitutes an emergency measure for the immediate preservation of public peace, property, health or safety, now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That this Council supports the Ohio Commission for the United States Semiquincentennial, AMERICA250-OH, and endorses their mission to educate, preserve, innovate, and celebrate every Ohioan in every county.

Section 2. That the Clerk of Council is directed to transmit copies of this resolution to the Municipal legislative delegation and AMERICA250-OH Commission, Michael Dylan Brennan, Regional Outreach Ambassador and Coordinator.

Section 3. That this resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
