EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The Department of Port Control is requesting authority to enter into one or more contracts with Engineered Arresting Systems Corp. dba Safran Arresting Systems for professional services necessary to inspect, maintain, and repair three Engineered Materials Arresting Systems (EMAS) at Cleveland Hopkins International Airport and Burke Lakefront Airport, for a period of one year with three one-year options to renew, the second of which requires additional legislative authority.

Background/Purpose:

The Department is required to maintain the integrity of the Engineered Materials Arresting Systems (EMAS) and seeks to enter into an agreement with Safran Aerospace to perform annual inspections, maintenance, and repairs to EMAS located on three runways at Cleveland Hopkins International and Burke Lakefront Airports. The EMAS is a vital part of the safety of the airports airfield and runway system.

Scope of Work:

To provide annual inspections, maintenance, and repair services as required of the EMAS to be performed by the authorized manufacturer's representative to mitigate system deficiencies and malfunctions that can result during the course of airfield operations and activities.

Justification/Urgency:

This service is required to ensure that the Department of Port Control maintains safe and secure runways at Cleveland Hopkins International and Burke Lakefront Airports. This is also a FAA Part 139 regulatory requirement.

Anticipated Cost: \$930,000.00

Schedule or Term of Contract:

One year with three one-year options to renew, the second of the one year options to renew shall not be exercised without additional legislative authority.
