Legislative Purpose	Authorizing the Director of Community Development to reallocate \$3,000,000 from the discontinued Cleveland Restoration Society program to Greater Cleveland Habitat for Humanity to support their critical home repair program.
Project Purpose	In 2024, the City funded Habitat through its Strategic Priority Subfund to undertake a home repair grant program providing critical repairs in neighborhoods where they were building new homes. In one year, they've completed over 70 home repairs. Their efficiency and experience have provided much-needed services to residents, many of whom are elderly or lack resources to make critical health and safety repairs and remain in their homes. Habitat will receive an additional \$3,000,000 to continue its successful critical home repair program.
