

Ordinance No. 378-2022

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

Authorizing the Clerk of Council to enter into a contract with Patterson-Pope, Inc. to purchase and install updated electronics for the electric powered mobile high density storage systems located at Cleveland City Council Archives.

WHEREAS, Cleveland City Council Archives uses two Spacesaver electric powered high density mobile storage systems; and

WHEREAS, the electric control systems on the Spacesaver storage systems, manufactured in the 1990s, are at the end of their serviceable life and the nationwide inventory of replacement parts was nearly exhausted in 2019; and

WHEREAS, additionally, Patterson-Pope, Inc., the Archives' Spacesaver representative, no longer supports the current electronic control systems, making it necessary to upgrade the Spacesaver electronics systems; and

WHEREAS, Patterson-Pope, Inc. is the sole Spacesaver certified and authorized distributor for sales, installation, service and warranty of Spacesaver products and services in Ohio; and

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That the Clerk of Council is authorized to enter into an agreement with Patterson- Pope, Inc. on the basis of its proposal dated March 30, 2022, for the purchase and installation of updated electronics for the two existing Spacesaver electric powered high density mobile storage systems located at the Cleveland City Council Archives.

Section 2. That the cost of the contract shall be paid from Fund No. 01-001-0101 and/or 11-006.

Section 3. That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
